

## Yo-Yo Pincushion

### For this project you will need:

Scrap fabric  
2 Large buttons  
Fiber stuffing or scrap quilt batting  
Needle and quilting thread

### Making the Yo-Yo

Make one 4" (cut fabric into a 8-1/2" circle) yo-yo. Before completely gathering up the fabric, leave enough of an opening to stuff a lot of fiber stuffing or scrap quilt batting inside. After stuffing the yo-yo, gather up the fabric and tie off as you do with a normal yo-yo. Crisscross stitch to help close the opening as shown in Figure 1.

### Adding the buttons

Sew one button to each side of the yo-yo. Run your thread thru the center of the pincushion so you can pull the buttons snug as show in Figure 2. When your pincushion is sat on a flat surface, the button should not touch the surface

Your Pincushion is ready to be enjoyed!

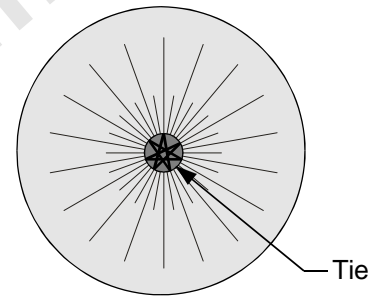

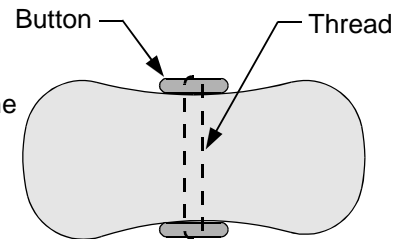
