

Yo-Yo Wreath

For Christmas Ornament you will need:

Scrap Christmas fabric
6" embroidery thread
8" of 3/8" wide ribbon
Needle and quilting thread

For Lapel Pin you will need:

Scrap Christmas fabric
1" sew on pin
8" of 1/4" wide ribbon
Needle and quilting thread

Making the Yo-Yo's

For Christmas Ornament - Make twelve 1-1/2" (cut fabric into a 3-1/2" circle) yo-yo's from assorted or the same Christmas fabric.

For Lapel Pin - Make twelve 1" (cut fabric into a 2-1/2" circle) yo-yo's from assorted or the same Christmas fabric.

Connecting the Yo-Yo's

Tack the yo-yo's together to form a string of yo-yo's as shown in Figure 1. Take the last yo-yo and tack it to the first yo-yo to create a ring as shown in Figure 2.

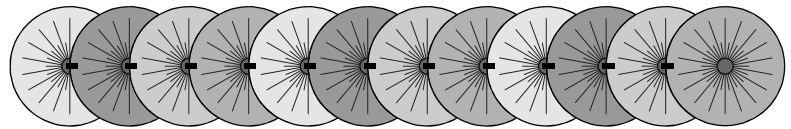

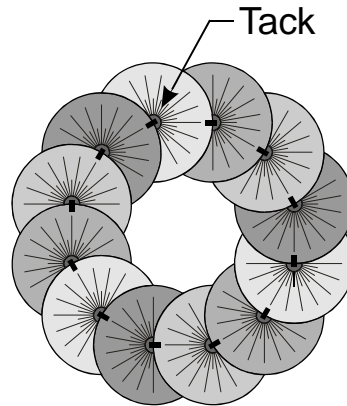

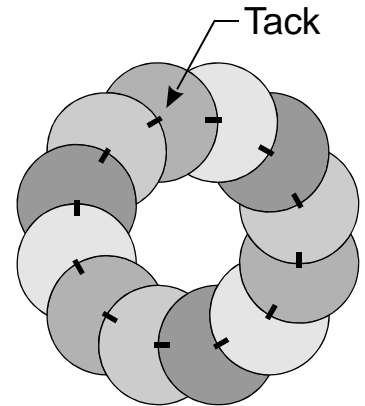

Connecting the back of the Yo-Yo's

Lay the wreath face down on an ironing board. Shape the wreath so that it is round. Use spray on starch and iron the wreath. Do not press hard. The starch will help keep the shape to finish the wreath. Tack the back of the yo-yo's as shown in Figure 3.

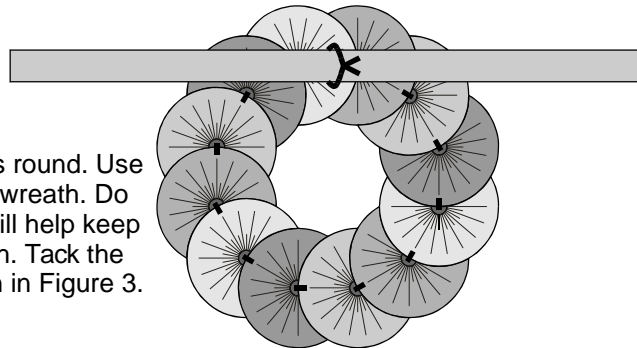

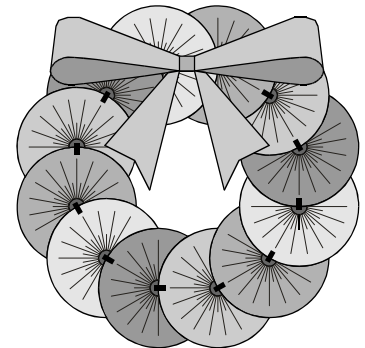

Attaching the Bow

Use thread to tie on an eight inch long 1/4" wide ribbon. Cut the thread ends to 1/4" as shown in Figure 4. Tie a cute bow with the ribbon. See Figure 5.

You can add beads to make your wreath special.

Making your Wreath into an Ornament

Adding the Hang String - Tie a loop with embroidery thread thru the top yo-yo. See Figure 6.

Making your Wreath into a Lapel Pin

Adding the Pin - Sew a pin on the back as shown in Figure 7.

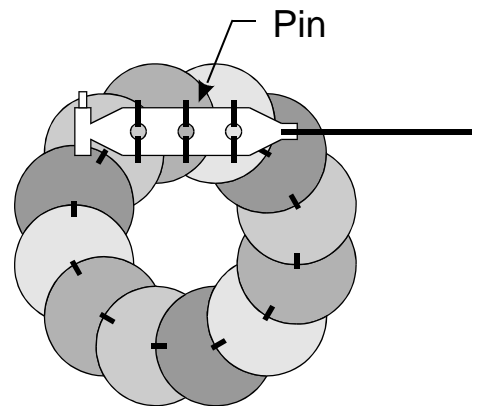
