

# Yo-Yo Wreath

## For this project you will need:

### For Christmas Ornament

Scrap Christmas fabric  
6" embroidery thread  
8" of 3/8" wide ribbon  
Strong button/craft thread  
Fiber stuffing or scrap quilt batting  
Needle and quilting thread

### For Lapel Pin

Scrap Christmas fabric  
1" sew on pin  
8" of 1/4" wide ribbon  
Strong button/craft thread  
Fiber stuffing or scrap quilt batting  
Needle and quilting thread

## Making the Yo-Yo's

For Christmas Ornament:

Make twelve 1-1/2" (cut fabric into a 3-1/2" circle) yo-yo's from assorted or the same Christmas fabric. Before completely Gathering up the fabric, leave enough of an opening to stuff a little fiber stuffing or scrap quilt batting inside. After stuffing the yo-yo, gather up the fabric and tie off as you do with a normal yo-yo.

For Lapel Pin:

Make twelve 1" (cut fabric into a 2-1/2" circle) yo-yo's from assorted or the same Christmas fabric. Before completely Gathering up the fabric, leave enough of a hole to stuff a little fiber stuffing or scrap quilt batting inside. After stuffing the yo-yo, gather up the fabric and tie off as you do with a normal yo-yo.

## Connecting the Yo-Yo's

String the yo-yo's together with a craft thread. Run your thread through the yo-yo's again as shown in Figure 1. Tie the thread, leaving a 1/4" opening through the middle of the yo-yo's.

## Attaching the Bow

Pull the thread to the front. Tie on an eight inch long ribbon. Cut the thread ends to 1/4" as shown in Figure 2. Tie a cute bow with the ribbon. See Figure 3.

## Finishing

Making your Wreath into an Ornament - Adding the Hang String

Tie a loop with embroidery thread between the two top yo-yo's. Make sure that you capture the thread that is holding all the yo-yo's together. See Figure 4.

Making your Wreath into a Lapel Pin - Adding the Pin

Sew a pin on the back as shown in Figure 5.

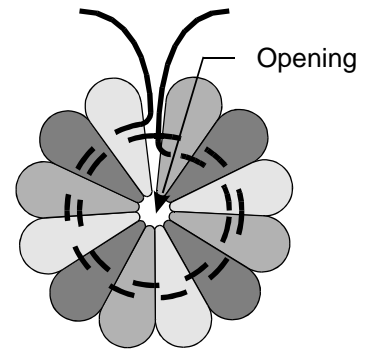

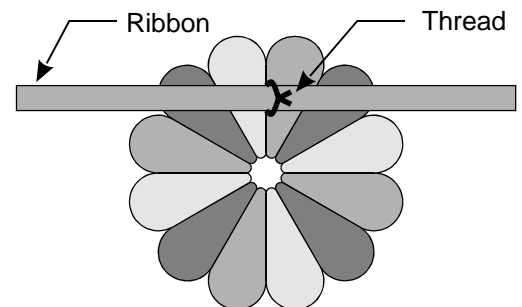

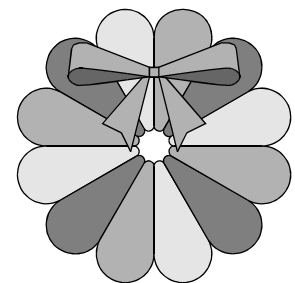

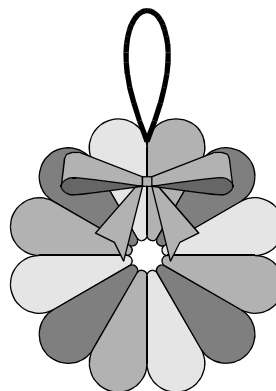

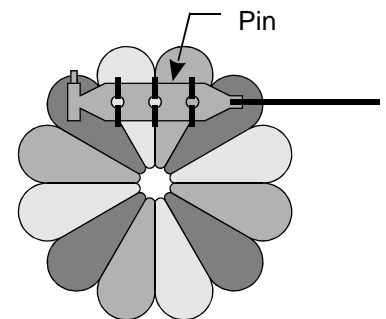
