

# Yo Yo Jewelry

**For this project you will need:** Scrap cotton fabric  
Spring ring clasp or barrel clasp  
Glue gun with 1 Pair flat ear posts or fish hook ear wire

**Special Instructions** - Use 1/8" turn under seam.

**Making a Bracelet** - Make eight 7/8" yo-yos (cut fabric in 2" circle). To increase or decrease size of bracelet, add or subtract some yo-yos. Whip stitch the yo-yos together to form a string of yo-yo's. Sew the clasp pieces on each end as shown in Figure 1.

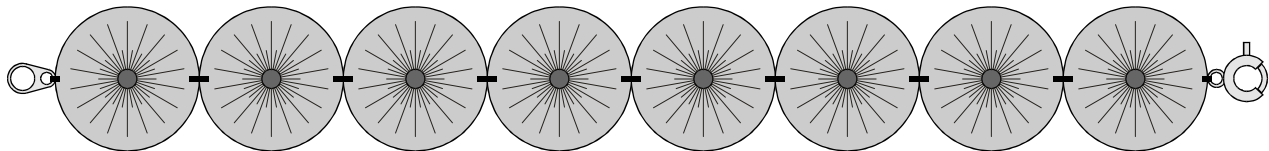

**Making Earrings** - Make two 5/8" yo-yos (cut fabric in 1-1/2" circle). Either use a glue gun to attach an ear post to the back of each yo-yo, or sew the yo-yos to a fish hook ear wire if your ears are pierced.

Your yo-yo jewelry is ready to be worn!

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
